Option 1: T-shirt Report!

After reading your book, purchase a t-shirt and some fabric paint!

- Decorate your shirt with a picture that tells about your story.
- Be sure to put the title of your book somewhere on your shirt.
- You can also decorate the back, or you can write about your favorite part of the story!

*We will have a special day during the first couple weeks of school for you to wear your "Book Report Shirt!" So have fun reading and creating!

Option 2: Book Report in a Bag!

Students will need a lunch size paper bag or gift bag.

- The outside of the bag should include:
 - Side 1: Title and author of book
 - Side 2: Illustrations, pictures and/or artwork relevant to the book
- Inside the bag:
 - 5 items that symbolize the main parts of the story: characters, setting, problem/solution, etc.
