# 2022-2023 Registration Information Kindergarten-Eighth Grade

### **Registration**

January 1st – February 28 (Re-enrollment for current students and enrollment for siblings of current students and Redeemer Church member children)

 $$520 = 1^{st}$  child

\$420 = each additional child in K-8<sup>th</sup>

March 1<sup>st</sup> and thereafter (Open Enrollment)

 $$620 = 1^{st} \text{ child}$ 

\$520 = each additional child in K-8<sup>th</sup>

The registration fee is non-refundable and includes the following: rental of textbooks, purchase of consumable workbooks, classroom instructional supplies, standardized achievement testing materials and scoring, student accident insurance, classroom funds, school association fee (PTO), library replenishment, and fine arts programs (drama, music, and art).

The registration fee does not include the following: auction tickets, school pictures, sports fees, yearbook, hot lunches, class field trips, annual class trips, uniforms, technology fee, and other incidentals.

Before-School and After-School Extended Care is offered.

Morning Care is 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 a.m.

Afternoon Care is 3:15 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. The Extended Care Registration Fee is \$25 per child. Morning Care is \$5.00 per day and Afternoon Care is \$15.00 per day.

Redeemer Lutheran Church and School is a not-for-profit organization. The school admits students of any race, religion, color, national or ethnic origin.

### **Tuition Information**

# Annual Prepaid Payment Plan- Must be paid by one of the following methods: cash, check, cashier's check, money order or electronic funds transfer paid in full by July 31.

Kindergarten-  $8^{th}$  grade ( $1^{st}$  child) = \$8125.00 Each additional K- $8^{th}$  grade child = \$7312.50

### School's Automatic Withdrawal Payment Plan-

Funds will be drawn by Redeemer in ten monthly payments from a checking or savings account the first business day of the month starting in August and finishing in May. Paperwork for the withdrawals must be received by June 10.

Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup> grade (1<sup>st</sup> child) = \$8425.00 [\$842.50/month] Each additional K-8<sup>th</sup> grade child = \$7582.50 [\$758.25/month]

# <u>Standard Payment Plan- Paid by any of the following methods: cash, check, cashier's check, money order, electron funds transfer or credit card.</u>

Tuition shall be paid in ten monthly payments on the first of the month starting on July 1 and finishing on April 1.

Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup> grade (1<sup>st</sup> child) = \$8425.00 [\$842.50/month]Each additional K-8<sup>th</sup> grade child = \$7582.50 [\$758.25/month]

\*\*\*NOTE: If paying with a credit card, a convenience fee will be applied commensurate with the fees charged.

#### **Discounts**

As shown above, families receive an approximate 4% discount if the tuition is paid in full by July 31 via cash, check, cashier's check, money order or electronic funds transfer. Additional children receive a discount per student (does not apply to preschool programs).

### **Late Fees and Penalties**

Tuition shall be due and payable in full on or before the first day of each month. Please contact the business office regarding special payment options. Tuition collected after the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month will automatically incur a \$35 late fee or 10% of the outstanding balance, whichever is less. NSF check fee or returned EFT fee is \$35.

### **Other Fees and Expenses**

For every K-8<sup>th</sup> grade student entering Redeemer for the first time, there is a \$50 application fee. For every 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade student entering Redeemer there will be a \$100 testing fee. For any student returning to the school after attending another school, there is a \$100 testing fee. If current standardized test results are provided, it is possible that the scores may be used in lieu of testing. Incoming Redeemer Kindergarten students may provide VPK assessments and it is possible that the scores may be used in lieu of the Kindergarten test. If no VPK assessment is available, a \$50 testing fee will be assessed. There are also fees which will apply to the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade families for class trips, and those will be determined at a later date. Please see handbook for fees applying to sports, tardies and detentions.

### **Technology Fee**

Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup> grade students will be charged a \$150 technology fee, which will be posted on the August 15 family statement.

Financial aid is available on an as-needed and available basis. Contact the school office for an application packet.

### Uniforms

Parents purchase school uniforms from an independent distributor; uniforms are not covered by tuition or the registration fee. You are welcome to items in the uniform closet, which has lightly worn uniforms free of charge.

\*\*\* Class trip fees are not included in registration or tuition.

\*\*\* Tuition payment breakdown for families registering after June 15 may differ from the above tuition rates based on date entering the school and available payment dates remaining in the school year.
