- 4. Preschool staff is covering the classes. One new substitute needs to be hired. There is a need to hire a preschool director ASAP. Russ has reached out to Synod. They will send us a list of candidates, but advised that it is unlikely anyone will move at this time of year. Karyn urges we move on this as quickly as possible. The board agreed we will be open to synodically trained or a non-synodically trained candidate.
- 5. We still need to hire a music teacher. Mrs. Foley has been substituting, but Karyn also needs her as a regular substitute for all the teachers.
- 6. We've been contacted by Helping People Succeed. They want to know if we want to contract with them again. We could make a referral to them for assistance with students with special needs. Russ will follow up with the director of Helping People Succeed to see what our involvement with them has been in the past.

Russ shared that Feb 16th is Christian night at the county fair. We are part of the sponsoring group that is sponsoring a group, Cane, who will be there. We may be able to do something with that, yet to be determined.
