Principal's Report

1. This week is NLSW (National Lutheran Schools Week) K-5 grade students sang in church on Sunday. Other special events include Grandparents' Day, Book fair, and the Talent Show.
2. School wide devotions are being held each day. They are being led by the 8th grade class.
3. Jim Essig attended chapel on Wednesday, Jan 18th. The Outdoor Library Box in Jim's honor was dedicated.
4. New staff: Stephanie Schwed has begun teaching in the 4 year old K-Readiness class.
5. Current enrollment is 255 students. There are 159 in K-8 and 96 are in the Preschool. Karyn has been giving a lot of tours.
6. Ram Jam Basketball season is wrapping up. We are now ready for flag football and cross country

Milena shared Pre-k readiness parents are concerned about two 4 year old classes merging into one Kindergarten class and availability of student positions. Karyn shared that the numbers usually work out between students moving to public schools, and some staying in a 4 year old class. If the class overfills students are put onto a wait list. There is no guarantee, but usually any current 4 y/o student desiring a K position is able to have one.
