Welcome to worship with the Redeemer family on Sunday, October 27! In ministry since 1955, Redeemer is a Christ-centered church that prepares, equips, and motivates adults and children to serve God while leading others to know and love Jesus Christ. Roof Update: Work on the sanctuary roof is underway and we are thrilled to report that we need *just over \$12,000 to fully fund the roof*. We required \$267,000 and thanks to your generosity we are almost there!

Today we join with 70 million Lutherans in remembrance of the people and events of the Reformation. The Reformation of the Western Christian Church began when Martin Luther nailed 95 theses (questions for discussion) on the Castle Church door in Wittenberg, Germany. This event ignited an on-going movement with the Gospel words "*It is by grace that we are saved through faith...it is a gift from God...not by works.*" as the Scriptural base for a reformed Church.
